#### **January**

- Welcome new members of the 136th Ohio General Assembly. Keep your legislators informed on what your library is currently offering.
- Register and attend the <u>OLC</u> <u>Advocacy Webinar</u> on Jan. 9.
- Make sure your legislator is on your library's newsletter mailing list.
- Review the advocacy tools on OLC website and watch for updates on the FY 2026-27 biennial budget process.

#### **February**

- Write an article about how your library is funded and how state funding through the Public Library Fund (PLF) impacts your library.
- Register and participate in the <u>Budget Webinar</u> on Feb. 13.
- Celebrate "Toni Morrison" Day on Feb. 18.
- Invite your legislators to be a part of your library's storytime for "Read Across America Day" on March 2.

#### March

- Register for the OLC's <u>Library</u> <u>Legislative Day</u> on April 8.
- Watch the OLC's Preparing for Library Legislative Day Webinar.
- Coordinate your Legislative Day Meetings with your Legislative Network Representative.

#### **April**

- Participate in the OLC's

- Share stories and photos on your library's social media pages. Be sure to tag your legislators.

#### May

- Ohio Primary Election Day is Tuesday, May 6.
- Celebrate In-Demand Jobs Week in Ohio.
- Share what your library is doing for In-Demand Jobs Week on social media and tag your legislators.
- Send your legislators a short note letting them know about job search assistance, workforce development services, and online educational courses provided by your library.

#### June

- Watch your inbox and respond to Calls-to-Action related to the State Budget Bill.
- Invite your legislators to read during storytime or participate in a Summer Reading Program event in June or July.
- Celebrate the National Week of Making. Share a picture of your library's makerspace on your social media pages #NationalMakers.

### July

- Send a thank you note to your legislators thanking them for their support of the PLF in the State Budget Bill.
- Invite your legislators to read during Storytime or participate in a Summer Reading Program event
- Watch the OLC's State Budget Bill Recap Webinar.

#### **August**

- The Ohio General Assembly is in recess.
   Make a point to attend meetings and events your legislators will be attending and invite them to special events at your library.
- Celebrate the end of your Summer Reading Program and Back to School season. Highlight library resources for students on social media.

# September

- Celebrate National Library Card Sign-Up Month; tag your legislators on social media.
- Work with your OLC Legislative Network Representative and organize an informal Legislative Breakfast with your legislators back in the district.

## October

- TeenTober is a month-long celebration promoting yearround teen services (TeenTober replaces YALSA's previous Teen Read Week and Teen Tech Week). Highlight programs and materials for the teens in your community.
- Register to attend the 2025 OLC Convention and Expo in Cleveland.

## November

- Election Day is Nov. 4.
- Veterans Day is Nov. 11.
   Highlight the programs and services your library offers to veterans. Be sure to share on your social media pages

   #VeteransDay.
- It's Picture Book Month. Invite a legislator to read during storytime.
- Celebrate OLC's 130th Anniversary at the OLC's Convention and Expo.

#### **December**

- Remember to invite legislators to holiday events and programs at your library.
